### **About the Course**

Doctor Nation will help the practitioner better understand the connection between bruxism, apnea, reflux, and occlusion. The course will review fundamental understanding of craniofacial development with relation to airway. It will review the physiologic principles of airway maintenance and how it relates to jaw position. The course will show the connections between sleep disturbance and its effect on the dentition. We will review the precepts of occlusion and how it affects airway and how airway may effect occlusion. The course will outline the signs that point to airway influence on the dentition and craniofacial complex.

The goals of the course are to help the practitioner as follows:

- \* Understand how the initial exam can help identify risk factors for airway influence on the dentition
- \* Review Occlusal Concepts
- \* Understand the physiologic reasons and influence of airway disturbance and the effects on the dentition
- \* Understand how to screen and then make appropriate referrals to our Physician counterparts
- \* Understand treatment modalities to help airway issues and stabilize dentition.

### **About Dr. Nation**

Dr. Nation attended the University of Louisville and obtained his Bachelor of Arts degree in Biology in 1996. He completed his dental training from the University of Louisville in 2000. Dr. Nation has been on staff as faculty in the department of Surgical and Hospital Dentistry at University Hospital in Louisville since 2003. He has been an attending doctor in the General Practice Residency Program in Louisville since 2003. Dr. Nation also teaches in the University of Louisville Graduate Prosthodontics program. He lectures to undergraduate DMD students on treatment planning and complex restorative cases at the University of Louisville Dental School.

Dr. Nation has been in private practice serving the Louisville area since 2003. The most complex cases in this area of the United States are typically referred to Dr. Nation for rehabilitative dental care. Dr. Nation works full time in private practice, part time at the University of Louisville, and regularly lectures to study clubs and in dental meetings.
